## SHSM- Contextualized Learning Activity Workplace/Technical Communication Unit

In this unit, you will reinforce and further develop literacy skills directly related to the workplace. These skills will help prepare you to communicate effectively in a variety of forms within given contexts.

You will be required to plan, design and promote a community service project that uses manufacturing CNC technology. One example of this type of project might be the production and distribution of key chains that promote safe driving practices.

In the **planning stage**, you will need to decide on the type of project and draw a sketch of the project.

In the **designing stage**, you will create a three-dimensional digital or solid model of your community project which will later be used during your presentation.

In the **writing stage**, you will be required to produce several forms of writing in tasks related to a variety of communication skills associated with the planning, designing, and promoting of your community project.

In the **promoting stage**, you will be required to prepare a presentation to financial supporters to gain their support for the project.
